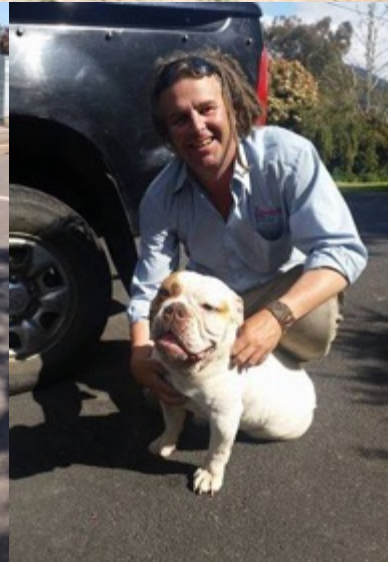
Who is S.C.A.R

- 9 council (84y) agreements with Victorian pounds

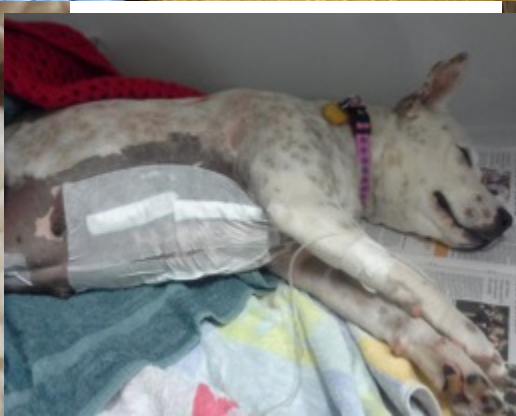

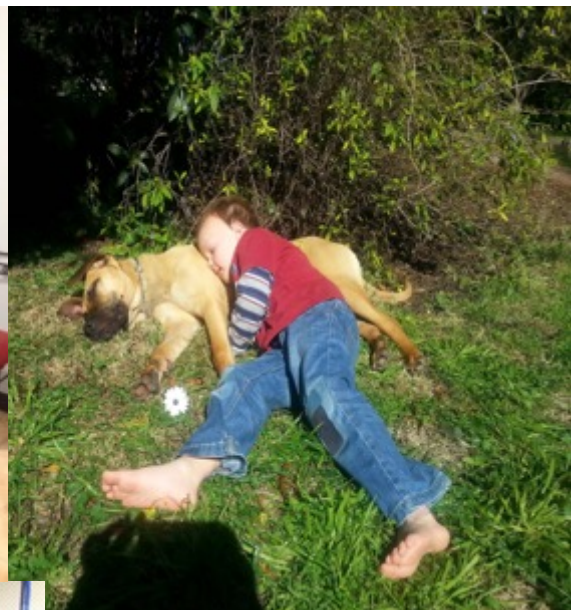
